Border related crime has an adverse impact on Texas and the entire nation. The freeways and roads that run through Seguin are being utilized for illicit purposes that have a nexus to the southern border.

I am requesting authorization to enter into an Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with the law enforcement entities associated with Operation Lone Star. Currently those entities include: Bee County SO, Brooks County SO, Cuero PD, Edna PD, Falfurrias PD, Goliad County SO, Kingsville PD, Kleberg County SO, Kleberg County Attorney Taskforce, Live Oak County SO, McMullen County SO, Nixon PD, Refugio County SO, San Patricio County SO, Wharton County SO, Wilson County SO, Yoakum PD, Gonzales County SO, Gonzales PD, Jackson County SO, Aransas County SO, Zapata County SO, Duval County SO, Hallettsville PD.

This agreement would allow Seguin PD to pool our resources and work with the listed agencies in sharing intelligence, coordinating criminal interdiction efforts to include human trafficking/smuggling and narcotics investigations.

Seguin officers would not be assigned to a full-time task force, simply assist with operations should we be able to spare the officers or resources. Assignment of Seguin Police Officers or resources to any Operation Lone Star activity will remain at my sole discretion. The listed agencies could also be called upon to assist us with operations that are consistent with the goals of Operation Lone Star.

There is also the possibility of sharing in forfeited assets that result from activity where Seguin PD participated.
