CITY OF SEGUIN

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin recognizes the need for the establishment of a Body-Worn Camera Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City of Seguin assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council authorizes the submission of an application to the Governor's Office Criminal Justice Division for funding the purchase of a body-worn camera system for use by the Seguin Police Department.

SECTION 2. The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Grant Program.

SECTION 3. The City Council agrees that all expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division guidelines and terms and conditions of the grant award. The City Manager will assure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with said guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of Office of the Governor funds, the City of Seguin assures that funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is in full force and effect from and after the date of passage.
