Subject: **Resolution of the City Council of Seguin, Texas establishing a “Drug Free Zone and a Gang Free Zone” in and around Park West; and establishing an effective date.**

On February 15, 2011, the City Council unanimously adopted a Resolution establishing a “Drug Free Zone and Gang Free Zone” in and around Max Starcke Park East, Max Starcke Park West, Manuel C. Castilla Park, Blumberg Park, and the Volleyball Complex. The Resolution established a 1,000 foot buffer around these park areas to assist in reducing drugs and gang activity near locations where children tend to gather and play.

The purpose of the proposed Resolution is to add Park West to the City’s adopted “Drug Free Zone and Gang Free Zone” to further deter drug and gang activity in and around the new community park. On May 4, 2015, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board will consider the proposed Resolution for City Council consideration.

City staff recommends approval of a Resolution of the City Council of Seguin, Texas establishing a “Drug Free Zone and a Gang Free Zone” in and around Park West; and establishing an effective date.
