

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AMENDING THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 22 (BUSINESSES), ARTICLE X, FOOD TRUCKS, SEC. 22-603, DURATION OF STAY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE, PUBLICATION AND A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO PREPARE THIS ORDINANCE FOR SUBMISSION AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin desires to provide its residents and visitors with a variety of dining options in Seguin; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin has established regulations that allow food trucks to operate within the city limits of Seguin in an orderly, safe and healthful manner; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin has recently approved an ordinance to extend the hours for the sale of beer, wine and mixed beverages for on-premises consumption in non-residential areas of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin desires to extend the hours that food trucks can operate to be consistent with the hours extended for the sale of on-premises alcohol in non-residential areas of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 22-603 of the Seguin Code of Ordinances, Food Trucks- Duration of stay, is hereby amended as follows (underlining indicates added text, ~~strike through~~ indicates deleted text):

Sec. 22-603. – Duration of stay.

- (a) Food trucks operating on private property shall not be parked on the property for a duration exceeding ten hours per location per day.
- (b) Food trucks operating from public streets shall not be parked in one location for a duration exceeding ten hours per location per day.
- (c) No food truck shall operate between the hours of ~~1:00~~ 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

In accordance with Section 3.10 of the Seguin City Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective ten days from passage on second reading and shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation.

SECTION 3. Severability.

If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portions of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

SECTION 4. Submission.

City staff is authorized to prepare this Ordinance for submission as a supplement to the Seguin Code of Ordinances.
