Presentation of FY2019 Audit Report - Nancy Vaughan, Armstrong, Vaughan and Associates, P.C.

Nancy Vaughan of Armstrong, Vaughan & Associates presented a Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2019. The report is presented in three sections: introductory, financial, and statistical. The report includes all funds of the City. 2019 was a very successful year for the City of Seguin and the Seguin Economic Development Corporation.

Long Term Financial Planning:

The City issued \$305,000 in Tax Anticipation Notes to provide funding for the purchase of larger pieces of equipment. The City also issued 2019 General Obligation Bonds in the amount of \$14,570,000 to provide for the refunding of the 2010 Utility Revenue Bonds (\$7,240,000 outstanding) and 2010 Certificates of Obligation (\$9,850,000 outstanding).

Internal Control:

Management is responsible for establishing and maintaining an internal control structure designed to ensure that the assets of the City are protected from loss, theft, or misuse and to ensure that adequate accounting data are compiled to allow for the preparation of financial statements in conformityconformity with generally accepted accounting principles for local governments as prescribed by the GASB, FASB, and AICPA.

Budgeting Controls:

The City maintains budetary controls. As demonstrated by the statements and schedules included in the financial section of this report, the City continues to meet it's responsibility for sound management.

Financial Rating:

The City's bond rating for Fitch Ratings and Standard & Poor's is AA/Stable Outlook for both the General Obligation Bonds & Utility Revenue Bonds.
