

STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS DECLARING THAT SPECIFIED VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT ARE OBSOLETE, DYSFUNCTIONAL, OR BEYOND SERVICABLE VALUE AND THEREFORE SURPLUS; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City has a number of older pickup trucks, police vehicles and heavy equipment ranging from eight to seventeen years old that are no longer economically viable for use in the City’s fleet; and

WHEREAS, according to the City’s policy any equipment whose original cost is more than \$5,000.00 must be declared surplus by the City Council before putting the equipment out for auction; and

WHEREAS, auctioning surplus equipment is approved by Texas law; and

WHEREAS, GovDeals handles numerous auctions for governmental entities and has conducted previous auctions for the City.

NOT THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas that:

SECTION 1. The vehicles and equipment set out in the attached table are no longer of use to the City and are hereby declared as surplus property.

SECTION 2. As surplus property city staff is hereby authorized to list the vehicles and equipment with GovDeals to be auctioned to the highest bidder.

SECTION 3. This resolution is in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
