A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR FOR A 2020 LOCAL BORDER SECURITY PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SUBMISSION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City has participated in the Operation Border Star for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, this grant program, administered through the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division, provides funds to sustain interagency law enforcement activity by assisting with the payment of overtime costs; and

WHEREAS, the police department is seeking \$20,800.00 in funding to cover the additional overtime costs for interdiction along IH-10 as well as State Highways 46 and 123; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Seguin that the Local Border Security Program be operated; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin shall provide applicable matching funds for said program as required by the Office of the Governor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Seguin authorizes City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, to submit a grant application to the Office of the Governor for the Local Border Star Security Program.

SECTION 2. The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with the City's participation in the grant program.

SECTION 3. The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor Funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
