A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AFFILIATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SEGUIN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND THE UNITED STATES ARMY MEDICAL CENTER OF EXCELLENCE TO ALLOW THE SEGUIN EMS TO SERVE AS A CLINICAL TRAINING SITE FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN PARAMEDIC AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, in order to serve as a clinical training site for students who are enrolled in emergency medical technician and paramedic programs the Seguin Fire Department entered into affiliation agreements with several community colleges and other entities that desire to participate in clinical training with the City's Emergency Services; and

WHEREAS, clinical training is an essential part of the training protocol for emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, the United States Army through their U.S. Army Medical Center of Excellence has requested that the City serve as one of its clinical training sites; and

WHEREAS, participating in clinical training programs is, in the long run, beneficial to the City's emergency medical service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin:

Part One: The attached Affiliation Agreement with the U.S. Army is approved and the City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, is authorized to execute the Affiliation Agreement.

Part Two: This Resolution is in full force and effect on and from the date of its approval.
