A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE, HOMELAND SECURITY GRANTS DIVISION, FY2023 LOCAL BORDER SECURITY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City Police Department is directed to provide law enforcement operations; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office is soliciting grant applications from Guadalupe County for coordinated border security operations: and

WHEREAS, the City is submitting a grant application entitled <u>FY23: Local Border Security</u> for law enforcement overtime salaries, benefits and equipment, not to exceed \$75,000, with no required matching funds in response to this grant solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1: The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of an application entitled <u>FY23</u>: <u>Local Border Security</u> to the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Homeland Security Grants Division.

SECTION 2: The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Grant Program, including the authority to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate this grant.

SECTION 3: Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office guidelines, terms and conditions of the grant award including all matching funds, if applicable. The City Manager will assure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with grant guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City of Seguin will return all funds to the Public Safety Office.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
