Subject: LED Lighting

The lighting on the SH 123 elevated storage tank was damaged during a lightning storm and requires replacement. A quote was obtained for replacement lighting and appurtenances from Crawford Electric for \$68,604.00. Crawford submitted their quote based on a Texas BuyBoard contract. Texas BuyBoard is a purchasing cooperative administered by the Texas Association of School Boards and purchases utilizing their contracts are compliant with Texas bidding requirements. This expense was not budgeted, however, because the damage was caused by lightning the City of Seguin has filed a claim with Texas Municipal League (TML), please note that TML has tentatively approved the claim, however they are waiting for Council action before moving forward with a final determination on the amount of the payout.

Staff recommends approval for expenses not to exceed \$75,000.00 which includes a \$6,396.00 contingency and will be available to answer any questions at the Tuesday, April 4, 2023, City Council meeting.
