A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN TEXAS APPROVING A LETTER OF ENGAGEMENT WITH CHARLES R. KIMBROUGH OF BICKERSTAFF, HEATH, DELGADO, ACOSTA, LLP FOR ASSISTANCE WITH REDISTRICTING; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, given the changes in population over the last decade the population in each of the City's single member districts has gotten out of balance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved a committee to recommend new district maps for City Council consideration; and

WHEREAS, in order to rebalance the districts and draw new district maps a significant amount of GIS work is needed; and

WHEREAS, to assist in the GIS work and insure compliance with the legal requirements surrounding the various elections, staff has solicited proposals from law firms experience in this area of law that also have GIS availability; and

WHEREAS, Charles R. Kimbrough of the law firm of Bickerstaff, Heath, Delgado, Acosta, LLP, who recently assisted Guadalupe County in their redistricting process submitted a proposal to assist the City of Seguin; and

WHEREAS, given their experience in redistricting, particularly in this area, city staff recommends the approval of a letter of engagement with Charles Kimbrough of the Bickerstaff firm.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin:

SECTION 1: The attached Letter of Engagement with Charles Kimbrough of Bickerstaff, Heath, Delgado, Acosta, LLP with is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: The city manager, is authorized to execute the engagement letter.
