## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS TO SET OUT PROCEDURES FOR OBTAINING PUBLIC INPUT TO NAME THE NEW 47 ACRE PARK BEING CONSTRUCTED USING THE PROCEEDS OF THE 2013 BOND FUNDS

**WHEREAS**, contractors are preparing to break ground on a new 47-acre community park on property that was purchased from the Hoermann family using the proceeds from a 2013 bond initiative; and

WHEREAS, current City policy sets out some requirements for naming city facilities; and

WHEREAS, City Council would like to have public input to find a name for this new park.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

**PART ONE.** In order to solicit public input in naming the new park, the City Council hereby adopts the following procedures:

1. Notice of a two week period to solicit suggestions for the name will be published in a manner that interested Seguin residents will be afforded the means to participate in the naming of the park.

2. Any resident of the City of Seguin may suggest a name for the facility. Submission may be made by e-mail, telephone to a voicemail box, or in-person at City Hall. To be considered, each person suggesting a name must include their identity and contact information.

3. In accordance with City policy, any suggested name that includes the name of a living person will not be considered in the final list.

4. At the close of the two week period, the City Council will select three to five names as finalists.

5. After the City Council determines the finalists, a two-week period will set up so that the public may vote on their favorite. Only residents may vote, and only one vote per person. Votes will be taken by e-mail, telephone to a voicemail box, or in person at City Hall.

6. The winning name will be submitted to the City Council for final approval. The person who submitted that winning name will be appropriately recognized.
