**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS
AWARDING A BID TO M&C FONSECA CONSTRUCTION FOR THE REPLACEMENT A
A FORCE MAIN USED TO TRANSFER WATER TREATMENT PLANT SLUDGE AT THE
WALNUT BRANCH WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AND APPROVING STAFF'S
NEGOTIATION A CONTRACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$852,931.75 FOR
THAT PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE
NEGOTIATED CONTRACT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, this Project for the Walnut Branch Wastewater Treatment Plant consists of replacing a nearly 30-year old force main that transfers wastewater sludge at the plant with a new eight inch line; and

WHEREAS, seven companies submitted responses to the City's request for proposals to construct the Project; and

WHEREAS, the bids, including additives, ranged from a low bid of \$852,931.75 from the M&C Fonseca Construction of Granite Shoals to a high base bid of \$1,510,495.55 from Wampole-Miller, Inc. of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, city staff, along with the City's Project design engineer Craig Bell of TRC, reviewed the bids and the references of the bidders; and

WHEREAS, based on references, experience with similar projects and bid amount city staff recommends awarding the bid to the low bidder, M&C Fonseca Construction; and

WHEREAS, city staff will negotiate a standard form contract in an amount not to exceed \$852,931.75 for execution by M&C Fonseca Construction.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. M&C Fonseca Construction is awarded the bid in an amount not to exceed \$852,931.75 replacement of the force main sludge line at the Walnut Branch Wastewater Treatment Plant.

SECTION 2. The city manager is authorized to execute a standard form contract with M&C Fonseca Construction for the Project.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
