A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE USE OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN FUNDS AND AWARDING A CONTRACT THROUGH THE BUYBOARD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$409,500.00 TO COURTEX CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE CONVERSION OF THE SAEGERT MIDDLE SCHOOL TENNIS COURTS TO PICKLEBALL COURTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH COURTEX CONSTRUCTION, INC.; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, through a transaction with the Seguin Independent School District the City acquired the Saegert Middle School tennis court located on Mountain Street; and

WHEREAS, city staff has previously recommended that the old tennis courts be repurposed for use as pickleball courts; and

WHEREAS, the project to convert the old tennis courts to pickleball courts is eligible for funding using the American Rescue Plan Act; and

WHEREAS, city staff has received a BuyBoard quote from CourTex Construction, Inc. ("CourtTex") to complete the first phase of the project that includes a new foundation, nine pickleball courts, new fencing around the perimeter and lighting; and

WHEREAS, city staff recommends entering into a contract with CourTex.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council approves the use of American Rescue Funds to award a BuyBoard contract to CourTex for repurposing the Saegert Middle School tennis courts into pickleball courts in an amount not to exceed \$409,500.00.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a construction contract for \$409,500.00 with CourTex for the work outlined herein.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
