

CITY OF SEGUIN

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE GRANT PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") issued a call for projects under the Transportation Alternatives Program for population areas less than 200,000; and

**WHEREAS**, nominations for eligible alternative transportation projects needed to be submitted by May 4, 2015; and,

**WHEREAS**, City staff has submitted an application for the A.J. Briesmeister Middle School/Texas Lutheran University Sidewalk Gap Project (the "Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated cost of the Project is \$369,326.00, which includes the City's match of \$73,865.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project will provide a safe pedestrian connection between the A.J. Briesmeister Middle School and an economically disadvantaged neighborhood passing through Texas Lutheran University such that the Project will be used by a large number of people.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the city of Seguin, Texas:

**Part 1.** The City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to TxDOT for a Transportation Alternatives Program Grant.

**Part 2.** All actions of the City Manager and staff in submitting the A.J. Briesmeister Middle School/Texas Lutheran University Sidewalk Gap Project as the Transportation Alternatives Program Grant is hereby ratified.

**Part 3.** The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with the City's participation in the TxDOT Transportation Alternatives Program Grant.

**Part 4.** This Resolution is effective on and after the date of its passage.
