**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY FOR A GRANT AIMED AT MITIGATING NONPOINT SOURCE WATER POLLUTANTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE GRANT APPLICATION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality is accepting applications for a grant to be used for mitigation of nonpoint source water pollutants in the Geronimo Creek Watershed; and

**WHEREAS**, failing septic systems are one of the contributors to nonpoint source water pollution in creek watersheds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is applying for a grant to assist in decommissioning septic systems in the Deerwood Circle and Sunrise Acres subdivisions after the homeowner’s connect to the city’s sanitary sewer system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Assistance Grant application will be in the amount of \$148,852.16 with a match by the city of \$59,540.85 of which \$53,563.95 can be contractual services for decommissioning and \$4,974.07 in administrative costs; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant program is the same as was used by the City in assisting in Oak Village North with the decommissioning of septic tanks after connection to the city sanitary sewer.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council of the City of Seguin authorizes City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, to submit a grant application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for a nonpoint source pollution mitigation grant.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with the City's participation in the grant program including the authority to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant..

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
