**Subject:** Resolution to submit application for the FY2025-2026 State Homeland Security (SHSP) and Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Supporting Border Crisis Response and Enforcement grant program

**Historical Background**

The Office of the Governor (OOG), Public Safety Office is currently accepting applications for the FY2025-2026 State Homeland Security (SHSP) and Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Supporting Border Crisis Response and Enforcement grant program. The purpose of this program is to provide funding to support state and local efforts to prevent terrorism and targeted violence and prepare for the threats and hazards that pose the greatest risk to the security of Texas citizens.

City staff would like to submit an application to this program for funding to purchase a Tactical Armored Van for the Seguin Police Department. The estimated cost for this project is \$175,100. There are no matching funds requirements for this program. Grant awards are expected to be announced in December of 2025. If the City is awarded this grant, the project will begin in January of 2026.

**Action Requested**

City Council must approve the resolution to authorize the submission of this grant application.

**Procurement Methodology & Funding Source**

If the grant is awarded, 100% of the funding will be secured through the grant.

Procurements will be made according to the City of Seguin Purchasing Policy and the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards, which is codified in Part 200 of Title 2 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

**Staff Recommendation**

Staff recommends approval of the resolution to authorize the submission of the grant application.
