**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE
SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
JUSTICE, BRIDGING IMMIGRATION-RELATED DEFICITS EXPERIENCED NATIONWIDE
GRANT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin Police Department is desiring to enhance the safety and protection of our community; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice, Bridging Immigration-Related Deficits Experienced Nationwide has announced a grant application for FY2025-2026 to locate and apprehend aliens who have committed crimes, collect and analyze evidence of criminal activities, investigate drug and human trafficking crimes, and support agencies in the detention and transportation of criminal aliens; and

WHEREAS, the City is submitting a grant application with a funding request not to exceed \$550,000 to create a non-sworn officer Evidence and Forensic Specialist position; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS,

1. The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of an application to the Department of Justice, Bridging Immigration-Related Deficits Experienced Nationwide grant program.
2. The City of Seguin directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to act in all matters in connection with this application and City's participation in the Grant Program.
3. Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the Bridging Immigration-Related Deficits Experienced Nationwide grant guidelines, terms and conditions of the grant award including all matching funds, if applicable. The City Manager will ensure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with grant guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City of Seguin will return all funds to the Department of Justice, Bridging Immigration-Related Deficits Experienced Nationwide Program
4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
