

**SEDC Resolution NO. 2022-20**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SEGUIN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR A GRANT FROM THE TEXAS WORKFORCE COMMISSION HIGH DEMAND JOB TRAINING PROGRAM, FOR THE FACILITATION AND CREATION OF HIGH-DEMAND JOBS IN THE CITY OF SEGUIN

**WHEREAS,** the Seguin Economic Development Corporation (the “SEDC”) is a public instrumentality and non-profit industrial development corporation duly established and operating under Texas Local Government Code, Chapters 501 and 504, *et seq.*, as amended, known as the Development Corporation Act of 1979 (the “Act”); and

**WHEREAS,** the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) High Demand Job Training Program (“Program”) was created to address skill gaps and ensure a talent pipeline to address industry needs, through collaborations between Local Workforce Development Boards and local Economic Development Corporations; and

**WHEREAS,** among Program resources are a Grant Program, the funds of which would enable the SEDC to offset costs for the purchase of industrial and other equipment which would better enable the SEDC to provide and facilitate job training facilities for the creation or retention of primary jobs within the City of Seguin; and

**WHEREAS,** the SEDC has reviewed the terms of the Grant Program application and the subsequent conditions and obligations of the SEDC should its application be granted; has considered and evaluated the benefits of the Grant Program, and has determined it to be in the best interest of the SEDC to apply for funding in accordance therein;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SEGUIN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Board of Directors hereby finds that all the recitals above are true and correct and are incorporated herein as if restated in full.

**SECTION 2.** The Board of Directors authorizes the Executive Director to take all necessary actions to apply for funding pursuant to the Grant Program, and authorizes the SEDC to leverage and match one dollar for each dollar which may be granted through the Grant Program; such financial obligation of the SEDC for such leverage and match shall not exceed \$150,000.00.

**SECTION 3.** Upon successful application to the Grant Program and receipt of funding, the Board of Directors authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate an Agreement on behalf of the SEDC with Workforce Solutions Alamo, as required by the Program; said Agreement to be provided to the SEDC for review and approval in a subsequent meeting.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution is effective upon passage.
