CITY OF SEGUIN

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF A NO PARKING LOADING ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF WEST NOLTE STREET ALONG THE BLOCK RUNNING FROM THE WEST PROPERTY LINE OF THE NEW LIBRARY SITE TO THE EASTERN LIMITS OF THE WALNUT BRANCH BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, with the creation of the new library, the Tavern on the Creek Restaurant, and increased pedestrian and bike traffic from the Walnut Creek Hike and Bike Trail, it is in the best interest of safety to limit parking to the south side of West Nolte Street.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. That the south side of the West Nolte Street between the west side of the property line of the new library site to the eastern limit of the Walnut Branch bridge be designated as a no parking loading zone.

SECTION 2. City staff is hereby directed to erect no parking loading zone signs along the south side of the West Nolte Street between the west side of the property line of the new library site to the eastern limit of the Walnut Branch bridge in accordance with this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Violations of this Ordinance shall be punished in accordance with the penalty provisions of the City of Seguin Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 4. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portion of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

SECTION 5. In accordance with Section 3.10 of the Seguin City Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective upon ten (10) days following passage on second reading and shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation.
