

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BLUEBONNET TRAILS COMMUNITY MHMR CENTER TO PROVIDE A BUS SHELTER AT ITS CONNECT SEGUIN BUS ROUTE STOP; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin has received a request from the Bluebonnet Trails Community MHMR Center (MHMR) to erect a bus shelter at its Connect Seguin Bus Route stop operated by the Alamo Council of Governments (“AACOG”); and

**WHEREAS**, this bus shelter stop will continue to be utilized by area residents and residents of Eden Place Apartments, Eden Cross Apartments, and Bluebonnet Trails Community MHMR Center clients; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has met with representatives from MHMR and AACOG and all concur that near the Jefferson Street entrance will be the best location for a bus shelter; and

**WHEREAS**, MHMR, AACOG, and the City of Seguin recommend adding the bus shelter to the Connect Seguin Bus route; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated total cost for the bus shelter, pad and installation of the shelter will not exceed \$7,200.00; and

**WHEREAS**, Bluebonnet Trails Community MHMR Center has agreed to assist in the installation of the shelter by providing access for the shelter pad and participating in the funding of the pad and installation fees.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

**PART 1:** The recommendation outlined above and shown on the attached new bus shelter for the Connect Seguin’s MHMR bus stop is hereby approved.

**PART 2:** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
