**Re:** Preston Street Pavement Improvements  
Bid No. TF-2016-25

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In October 2014, the City Council awarded the 123 Bypass Water Loop Phase II and III Project. The project upgraded the existing 8" water line to a 12" water line from Court Street (Hwy 90) down Preston Drive to Eastwood Drive (FM 466) to Joe Carrillo Boulevard. This project has since been completed.

In an effort to keep Preston Street from deteriorating from the water installation, City Council allocated money to overlay the street in addition to "spot patching" over the water line trench.

On March 15, 2016, three (3) bids were received ranging from a low bid of \$64,295.90, from Fuquay, Inc., to a high bid of \$103,794.87 from Lone Star Paving. The project includes edge mill and full mill with 1½" overlay, Type D hot mix asphalt concrete with tack coat and adjustment of the water valves to finish (flush) grade.

Staff has received no negative references and recommends Fuquay, Inc, be awarded the Preston Street Pavement Improvements Project in the amount of \$64,295.90.

Funding for the project will come from the General Fund Street/Highway/Drainage Project Fund.
