A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER EXECUTE A CONTRACT AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,500 WITH KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATING TO THE COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY ACTION PLAN FOR THE AUSTIN STREET, NELDA STREET, AND GUADALUPE STREET INTERSECTION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin City Council approved a resolution authorizing submission of a grant application for the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) IN August 2022, which was awarded to the City in 2023; and

WHEREAS, in October 2023, the council approved a professional services agreement with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for the purposes of the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Comprehensive Safety Action Plan in accordance with the terms of the grant; and

WHEREAS, the City desires standards and policies ensure the safe, equitable, and adequate accommodation of all users of our roadways; and

WHEREAS, the services to being performed by Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for the Project includes a comprehensive safety action plan (CSAP) to prioritize safety improvements and justify investment decisions; and

WHEREAS, the draft comprehensive safety action plan (CSAP) identifies the City's High-Injury Network and study corridors and intersections were selected for targeted recommendations; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to identify potential safety countermeasures at the intersection of Austin Street, Nelda Street, and Guadalupe Street; and

WHEREAS, city staff recommends executing a contract amendment to the professional services agreement for this Project with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby approves a contract amendment to the Professional Services Agreement in an amount of \$4,500 with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for professional services relating to the Comprehensive Safety Action Plan for the Austin Street, Nelda Street, and Guadalupe Street intersection.

SECTION 2. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
