A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITRUE OF \$94,898.19 FOR THE REMAINING PUNCHLIST ITEMS NEEDED TO COMPLETE THE GERONIMO CREEK SEWER PROJECT, PHASE V – OAK VILLAGE NORTH; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in December 2013, City Council approved an emergency time and materials construction contract, with Jordan Foster for the Phase I street improvements in the Oak Village North subdivision; and

WHEREAS, in March 2014, City Council approved a second emergency time and materials construction contract for the street improvements on the remaining streets (designated Phase II); and

WHEREAS, the project is nearing completion and the remaining construction, including mailboxes, sprinkler systems repair and replacement, hardscape material and final cleanup has begun; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for these items is \$94,898.19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sequin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The expenditure of \$94,898.19 for the work to be performed to complete the emergency contracts for the Geronimo Creek Sewer Project Phase V in Oak Village North is approved.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
