As part of an approved Capital Improvement Project in the FY24 budget, Keeley Construction has submitted a quote for repairing, asphalting, re-striping, sealing, and placing new curb stops at targeted parking areas located in Max Starke Park East. All work will ensure Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance. Work includes the following parking areas:

- Kids Kingdom parking area across from Little League fields 1 and 2 off of River Road East.
- Parking area between Little League fields 6 and 1.
- Patricia K. Irvine-King Pavilion parking area.
- Little League handicap parking area off of Wave Pool Drive.

Staff have received a TIPS quote from Keeley Construction in the amount of \$55,000. TIPS (The Interlocal Purchasing System) is a Local Government Purchasing Cooperative administered by region 8 Education Service Center located in Pittsburg, Tennessee. City purchases utilizing the TIPS cooperative are in compliance with all State bidding requirements.
