RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SELECTION OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES PROVIDERS FOR THE GLO CDBG-MIT GRANT PROGRAM AND GIVING THE AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS WITH PROVIDERS

WHEREAS, the GLO CDBG-MIT contract requires implementation by professionals experienced in the Engineering of State or federally funded disaster recovery projects, and;

WHEREAS, in order to identify qualified and responsive providers for these services a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) process for engineering services has been completed in accordance with GLO CDBG-MIT requirements, and;

WHEREAS, the Statement of Qualifications Proposals were received by the due date and have been reviewed to determine the most qualified and responsive providers for each professional service giving consideration to ability to perform successfully under the terms and conditions of the proposed procurement, integrity, compliance with public policy, record of past performance, and financial and technical resources;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The attached list of engineering firms be approved by council in the order in which they are listed and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and approve contract terms with the highest scoring firms to provide GLO CDBG-MIT project-related **engineering services.** If agreeable terms cannot be reach with the highest scoring firms, the City Manager is approved to cease negotiations and move to the next highest scoring firm(s) and begin negotiations. With agreeable terms met with the selected engineering firms, the City Manager is authorized to sign contracts with the firms.

SECTION 2: That any and all project-related services contracts or commitments made with the above-named service providers are dependent on the successful negotiation of a contract with the service provider.
