


Traffic Stop Data – Who We Stop









Summary

- Motor vehicle stops closely mirror the make up of the community:
 - Seguin census
 - Guadalupe County census
 - Motor vehicle crash data
- Alaska Native/American Indian drivers were more likely to receive a citation, however the majority of drivers stopped received a warning (70% average)

Summary

- 97% of 9747 traffic stops did not result in a search
- Alaska Native/American Indian drivers were searched at a lower rate than other races
- When a vehicle was searched across all races stopped, 73% of the time on average the search was non-discretionary.

Summary

- The Department received no complaints or racial profiling or biased-based policing in 2021
- The Department's policies are in compliance with State law and the Texas Police Chief's Recognition Program.
