

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A 2016- 2017 JUVENILE JUSTICE LOCAL GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE GRANT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin recognizes the need to support programs that prevent juvenile delinquency and improve the juvenile justice system; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin desires to submit an application for a grant to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, to seek funds to support the Seguin Youth Services Youth Engaged to Succeed (YES) Project; and

**WHEREAS**, if awarded, the City of Seguin will enter into an Agreement with Seguin Youth Services regarding the use of the funds and their continuing obligation to the City should any challenges to said use arise; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds awarded, the City of Seguin assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin has authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS,**  
as follows:

The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of an application to the Governor's Office Criminal Justice Division's 2016-2017 Juvenile Justice Local Grant Program for funding the Seguin Youth Services Youth Engaged to Succeed (YES) Project.

The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters as the authorized official in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Grant Program.

Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the Criminal Justice Division guidelines and terms and conditions of the grant award. The City Manager will assure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with said guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of Office of the Governor funds, the City of Seguin assures that funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.
