CITY OF SEGUIN

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, VICTIM COORDINATOR AND LIAISON GRANT (VCLG).

WHEREAS, the City maintains programs to assist victims of crimes, including the position of Crime Victim Liaison; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Attorney General has announced a Victim Coordinator and Liaison Grant for FY2025-2026 to provide funding to for the position of Crime Victim Liaison; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered and supports the Application to be filed with the OAG; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has designated the City Manager as the Authorized Official who is given power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate that certain grant with the OAG, as well as given the authority to sign all grant adjustment requests, inventory reports, progress reports, and financial reports, or any other official document related to the grant on behalf of the grantee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS,

1. The City of Seguin approves the submission of an application to the Office of the Attorney General.
2. The City of Seguin directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to act in all matters in connection with this application and City's participation in the Grant Program.
3. Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the Office of the Attorney General guidelines, terms and condition of the grant award including all matching funds, if applicable. The City Manager will ensure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with grant guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City of Seguin will return all funds to the Office of the Governor Public Safety Office.
4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
