Subject: Ordinance restricting through truck traffic on Coral Sky and Saddlehorn Drive

Date: July 16, 2024

Current City ordinance designates “no through truck traffic” streets as streets with a restriction on through commercial vehicles with two or more rear axles unless they are making a delivery to an address on that street. Traffic caused by neighboring land uses of agricultural and industrial traverse between Rudeloff Road and State Highway 46. Coral Sky nor Saddlehorn Drive is classified on the City’s Master Thoroughfare Plan, therefore classified as local streets. There are many homes fronting both streets and the primary land uses are residential.

Due to the surrounding residential land uses and residents’ concerns of detouring traffic from current construction projects, staff is recommending a through truck restriction on Coral Sky and Saddlehorn Drive.

Citizen(s) have requested a through truck restriction on Coral Sky and Saddlehorn Drive. Staff will be available to answer any questions at the July 16, 2024 City Council meeting.
