A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL PURCHASING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SEGUIN AND THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS FOR MUTUALLY BENEFICIAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING.

PART ONE. The attached Interlocal Purchasing Agreement between the City of Seguin and Fort Worth, Texas is approved.

PART TWO. The City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler is authorized to execute the Interlocal Purchase Agreement.
