Re: Seguin ISD Request for Cedar Street Closure/Detour

As you are aware construction of the new Seguin High School is about to begin and is scheduled to last for two years. During construction student parking and the contractor's staging area are planned to be on the Oak Park Mall property. The school district has requested that Cedar Street be permitted to be closed Monday through Friday from Lamar to Cardinal during the during this construction period. Please see the attached letter. The Police Chief, Fire Chief, and City Engineer have each reviewed this request and have no objection to this closure. The school district was also required to get TxDOT's approval since Cedar Street intersects with two State highways which they have done.

Staff again has no objection to this request with the requirement that the school district will be required to maintain the placement and removal of all closure and detour signage during this period in accordance with the requirements of TxDOT and/or the City Engineer.

A representative from the school district will be present at the City Council meeting if there are any questions.
