A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING A PROPOSAL FROM D&D SITEWORK AND UTILITIES RELATED TO REPLACEMENT OF A 42" CORRUGATED STEEL STORM SEWER PIPE AT THE INTERSECTION OF SAUNDERS AND MEDLIN; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, 320 linear feet of pipe has degraded and has begun to fail, causing a hazard at the intersection of South Saunders and Medlin; and

WHEREAS, staff consulted with prospective contractors, receiving comprehensive proposals from Lewis Concrete Restorations and D&D Sitework and Utilities; and

WHEREAS, due to the condition and location of the pipe, this particular contract is eligible for exemption from formal procurement pursuant to Section 252.032(a)(1) and (a)(2) of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, city staff recommend approval of D&D Sitework and Utilities proposal, which will have a total budgetary impact of \$210,000, including work to be performed by City forces.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The proposal from D&D Sitework and Utilities is hereby approved, and Public Works is authorized to contract with D&D Sitework and Utilities to repair the storm sewer pipe at South Saunders and Medlin, in an amount not to exceed \$144,000.

Part 2. Public Works shall utilize its paving crew to repair the intersection of South Saunders and Medlin after D&D Sitework and Utilities has completed its work, with an estimated cost of \$65,000 for the paving work.

Part 3. This Resolution is effective from and after the date of its passing.
