**Subject:** **Resolution releasing property from the City's ETJ as requested by Catherine Medlin, for Property ID 28834**

**Date:** September 26, 2023

Senate Bill 2038, passed during the 2023 legislative session, provides procedures for a landowner to seek release from a municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) by filing a petition with the City. The petition must meet certain requirements to qualify for release.

The City of Seguin has received a request from Catherine Medlin to release a .29-acre parcel of land that she owns from the City's ETJ. Staff has verified that the request meets the requirements of the State statute. Catherine Medlin is the sole owner of the property. Per the new statute, the City of Seguin must release the property from the ETJ.
