Subject: Ordinance restricting parking on both sides of Rudeloff Road between SH 46 and Huber Road

Date: February 21, 2023

Current City ordinance restricts parking along a portion of Rudeloff Road near both intersections with Huber Road. The currently posted no parking zone signs are not consistent with the description of the no parking zone described in ordinance, but meet the needs to allow for the safe flow of traffic along Rudeloff Road. As a part of the Rudeloff Road Phase 1 project, staff evaluated the current no parking zone and is recommending revising the ordinance to restrict parking, standing, or stopping on the newly widened Rudeloff Road between SH 46 and the easternmost intersection with Huber Road. If approved, signs will be installed as a part of the road construction project.

In April 2016, the City of Seguin was awarded funding from the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) Transportation Improvement Program Surface Transportation Program – Metro Mobility (STPMM) for the Rudeloff Road, Phase 1, from SH 46 to Huber Road. The project will consist of reconstructing the existing narrow road with a 70' wide asphalt roadway section, including two (2) lanes each way, a left turn lane with bicycle lanes, sidewalks and related appurtenances.

The City has completed the design phase of the Rudeloff Phase 1 project and is in the process of preparing for advertisement. The project is expected to begin construction by May 2023.

City staff is recommending revising the existing no parking zone on Rudeloff Road to create a no parking, standing, or stopping restriction on Rudeloff Road between SH 46 and the easternmost intersection with Huber Road and will be available to answer any questions at the February 21, 2023 City Council meeting.
