A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDED A BID TO SOAP ENGINEERING, LLC FOR THE FIBER OPTIC COMMUNICATION INFRASTRUCTURE & SCADA INTEGRATION – 8TH ST CORRIDOR PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SOAP ENGINEERING, LLC; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Utilities Department has been working with the IT Department to ensure fiber optic communication infrastructure and SCADA integration is provided to serve our water / wastewater utility facilities; and

WHEREAS, there are some areas along the 8th Street corridor that require installing network/SCADA enclosures, communication hardware, fiber optic terminations, conduit connections, integrations with existing meter-site fiber, and modifications to the City’s existing water utilities SCADA production environment; and

WHEREAS, the above referenced project is to install communications and SCADA improvements at the following locations: 8th Street Pressure Reducing Valve (PRV) Site, 8th Street Rio Nogales Power Plant (RNPP) Vault Metering Site, and Two (2) Niagara Meter Sites and other necessary appurtenances; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids for the Fiber Optic Communication Infrastructure & SCADA Integration – 8th St Corridor Project; and

WHEREAS, three bids were received ranging from a low bid of \$132,296.00 to a high bid of \$247,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin reserves the right to award this contract to the lowest responsible bidder or to the bidder who provides the “best value” for the City; and

WHEREAS, based on the reference checks, City staff recommends accepting the low bid of \$132,296.00 submitted by SOAP Engineering, LLC plus \$17,704.00 in contingency for a total amount of \$150,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The City Council of Seguin, Texas, hereby approves the bid submitted by SOAP Engineering, LLC in the amount of \$132,296.00 for the Fiber Optic Communication Infrastructure & SCADA Integration – 8th St Corridor Project, plus \$17,704.00 in contingency for a total amount of \$150,000.00.

Part 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with SOAP Engineering, LLC for the Fiber Optic Communication Infrastructure & SCADA Integration – 8th St Corridor Project.

Part 3. This Resolution is effective from and after the date of its passing.
