A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A FRAZER TYPE I AMBULANCE ON AN INTERNATIONAL CV 515 DIESEL CHASSIS THROUGH THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON AREA COUNCIL (HGAC) COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE PURCHASE DOCUMENTS WITH PLILER INTERNATIONAL; APPROVING THE TRADE-IN OR AUCTION OF AN EXISTING UNIT; AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE NOT TO EXCEED \$340,000.00; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin recognizes that a reliable ambulance fleet is essential for ensuring timely and effective emergency medical care and maintaining public trust in the City's safety infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Fire/EMS Department has identified a need to replace aging equipment to minimize delays and reduce the risk of mechanical breakdowns during critical transport; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends the purchase of a Frazer Type I ambulance on an International CV 515 Diesel chassis; and

WHEREAS, the City is a member of the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) cooperative purchasing program, which allows local governments to benefit from volume discount pricing and expedited procurement while ensuring compliance with state bidding requirements; and

WHEREAS, the specific unit is available through the HGAC contract utilizing Pliler International as the dealer; and

WHEREAS, funding for this purchase has been approved and allocated in the FY26 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the purchase includes the replacement of an existing fleet vehicle, Unit #319 (VIN # 1FDRF3GT0LEC54477), which Staff recommends be approved for trade-in or auction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

Part 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the purchase of one (1) Frazer Type I ambulance on an International CV 515 Diesel chassis through the HGAC cooperative purchasing agreement, utilizing Pliler International as the dealer in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Forty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$340,000.00).

Part 2. The City Council hereby declares Unit #319 (VIN # 1FDRF3GT0LEC54477) as surplus property and authorizes the City Manager to utilize said unit as a trade-in towards this purchase or to dispose of the unit through public auction, whichever method provides the best financial value to the City.

Part 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption. PASSED AND ADOPTED this 16th day of December, 2025.
