AN ORDINANCE OF THE SEGUIN CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING CREEKSIDE STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Creekside Street, from San Antonio Avenue to North Vaughan Avenue is presently a two way street; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the Walnut Branch Hike and Bike Trail Creekside the city engineer determined that the portion of Creekside Street that is useable by motor vehicles is too narrow for safe passage in two directions; and

WHEREAS, given the available streets, it is in the best interest of public safety to make Creekside Street a one-way street travelling from San Antonio Avenue to Vaughan Avenue; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51.001, the City has general authority to adopt an ordinance or police regulation that is for the good of the government, peace or order of the City and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the City; and, the Code of Ordinances 98-68 makes allowance for the designation of one-way streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Seguin:

1. A one-way street is hereby created on Creekside Street from San Antonio Avenue to Vaughan Avenue within the City of Seguin:
2. The City's Public Works Manager is hereby authorized to designate the Creekside Street as a one-way street in accordance with this Ordinance, and is further directed to erect appropriate signs or other markings giving notice thereof:
3. Violations of this Ordinance shall be punished in accordance with the penalty provisions of the City of Seguin Code of Ordinances.
4. In accordance with Section 3.10 of the Seguin City Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective upon ten (10) days following passage on second reading and shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation.
5. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the

remaining portion of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.
