Subject: Resolution to submit application for the FY2025-2026 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) LEPTA grant program

Historical Background

The Office of the Governor (OOG), Public Safety Office is currently accepting applications for the FY2025-2026 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) - Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Activities (LETPA) grant program. The purpose of this program is to provide funding to build and sustain the capabilities necessary to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism.

City staff would like to submit an application to this program for funding to purchase a Mobile Incident Command Vehicle for the Seguin Police Department. The estimated cost for this project is \$560,000. There are no matching funds requirements for this program. Grant awards are expected to be announced in September of 2026. If the City is awarded this grant, the project will begin in October of 2026.

Action Requested

City Council must approve the resolution to authorize the submission of this grant application.

Procurement Methodology & Funding Source

If the grant is awarded, 100% of the funding will be secured through the grant.

Procurements will be made according to the City of Seguin Purchasing Policy and the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards, which is codified in Part 200 of Title 2 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of the resolution to authorize the submission of the grant application.
