**Subject:** Ordinance establishing an all-way stop at the intersection of Cordova Road and Huber Road

**Date:** May 3, 2022

Engineering staff received a request for an all-way stop at the intersection of Cordova Road and Huber Road. The intersection has four approaches and is currently controlled by stops on Huber Road. Cordova Road has a posted speed limit of 45 mph at the intersection with Huber Road and is classified on the Master Thoroughfare Plan as a major arterial. Huber Road has a posted speed limit of 40 mph and functions as a collector roadway.

An engineering review with traffic counts was conducted in accordance with the *Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (TMUTCD)*. Additionally, the intersection crash history was reviewed.

Based on the result of these investigations, an all-way stop is warranted at this intersection at this time and staff is recommending that an all-way stop be installed. Staff will be available to answer any questions at the May 3, 2022 City Council meeting.
