AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AMENDING THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 102, UTILITIES, AMENDING APPENDIX C – FEE SCHEDULE, CHAPTER 102, UTILITIES, ARTICLE III, WATER MODELING FEE; AND ARTICLE IV, WASTEWATER MODELING FEE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO SUBMIT THIS ORDINANCE AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, periodically the City reviews its water and wastewater modeling fees; and

WHEREAS, the water and wastewater modeling service identify infrastructure needs to deliver safe and reliable water and wastewater service; and

WHEREAS, the fees proposed by this Ordinance are set to recover cost of service.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

Section 1. Chapter 102, Utilities, Article III, Water, Subsections (q) (rest of section and subsections remain the same) is amended as follows (underlining indicates added text, ~~strikethrough~~ indicates deleted text):

(q)	Water Modeling Fee:		
	(1)	Per subdivision request.....	2,500 <u>3,000</u>

Section 2. Chapter 102, Utilities, Article IV, Wastewater Subsections (i) (rest of section and subsections remain the same) is amended as follows (underlining indicates added text, ~~strikethrough~~ indicates deleted text):

(i)	Wastewater Modeling Fee:		
	(1)	Per subdivision request.....	2,500 <u>3,000</u>

Section 3. In accordance with Section 3.10 of the Seguin City Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective beginning November 4, 2025, said date being at least ten days after publication of this ordinance.

Section 4. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portions of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

Section 5. City Staff is hereby authorized to submit this Ordinance as a supplement to the Seguin Code of Ordinances.
