A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS FOR MUNICIPALLY OWNED INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR LED LIGHTING RETROFITS FOR THE STATE ENERGY CONSERVATION OFFICE (SECO) LOCAL GOVERNMENTS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City's Parks and Recreation Department has authority to maintain the recreational facilities in our City; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to avail itself of all potential funding to improve facilities in our community whenever available and strives to be energy efficient by reducing energy consumption in all our facilities resulting in cost savings and improved visual quality: and

WHEREAS, the City is submitting a grant application to SECO that will, if funded, provide up to \$50,000 for each of three projects to retrofit existing lighting fixtures with LED lighting retrofits. Each project will require a 20% match of City funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of this application.

SECTION 2: The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Grant Program, including the authority to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate this grant.

SECTION 3: Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the guidelines, terms and conditions of the grant award including all matching funds, if applicable. The City Manager will ensure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with grant guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City of Seguin will return those funds.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
