

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, TEXAS RURAL BUSINESS FUND (TxRBF) GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City must approve all grant applications over \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the Seguin Economic Development Corporation (SEDC) would like to partner with the City through a written agreement; and

WHEREAS, grant funds are to be used to make infrastructure improvements and partner with a local company that will create at least 25 full-time jobs; and

WHEREAS, infrastructure improvements will be made on Lawson Street to the west of Tyson Foods, Inc. not to exceed \$1million in grant funds (with a 10% SEDC match) and will provide a minimum of 25 new full-time jobs at Tyson Foods, Inc; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has previously authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of a \$1million application to the TxRBF grant program.

SECTION 2: The City will enter into an agreement with the SEDC to perform this grant.

SECTION 3: The City Council reaffirms, directs, and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate this grant and to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Grant Program.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
