At the request of the City of Seguin, TRC Engineers, Inc. prepared a professional engineering service proposal for final engineering related to the design of approximately 10,500 linear feet of 24-inch water transmission main pipeline extending from the Vetter Booster Station to the Highway 123 Elevated Storage Tank (EST). The scope of work includes topographical surveying, appraisal / acquisition services, geotechnical, permitting, construction documents, and bidding / construction support to include limited construction inspections. In addition to engineering service, TRC will provide an environmental scope of work to include, Texas Historical Commission antiquities permit application and research design as well as archeological survey and report.

Services will be provided in accordance with the Master Service Agreement (dated December 16, 2003) executed by the City and TRC. The funding source is through the 2022 utility revenue bonds. Staff recommends acceptance of this engineering proposal in the amount of \$1,120,962.00 and will be available to answer any questions at the Tuesday, June 7, 2022 City Council Meeting.
