## **STATE OF TEXAS**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 98, TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE II, TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, TO REPEAL SECTION 98-62 AND 98-63, PLAY STREETS; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS**, in 1964, City Council adopted Sections 98-62 and 98-63 which allowed the traffic engineer to declare any street or part thereof a play street; and

**WHEREAS**, studies performed over the last ten years indicate that such declarations are of little value in reducing pedestrian crashes, vehicle speeds, or legal liability; and

WHEREAS, it is no longer recommended to declare any street or part thereof a play street.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS

**SECTION ONE.** The Seguin Code of Ordinances, Sections 98-62 and 98-63 is amended to repeal Sections 98-62 and Sections 98-63 in its entirety.

**SECTION TWO.** All ordinances and resolution or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

**SECTION THREE**. This Ordinance shall become effective beginning ten days after its publication.

**SECTION FOUR.** City Staff is hereby authorized to submit this Ordinance as a supplement to the Seguin Code of Ordinances.
