RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE CRIME PREVENTION AUTHORITY GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Texas Transportation Code Chapter 1006 and Texas Administrative Code Title 43; Part 3; Chapter 57, entities are eligible to receive grants from the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority to provide financial support to law enforcement agencies for economic motor vehicle theft and fraud-related motor vehicle crime enforcement teams; and

WHEREAS, this grant program will assist this jurisdiction to combat motor vehicle theft, motor vehicle burglary and fraud-related motor vehicle crime; and

WHEREAS, this grant program will assist this jurisdiction to combat catalytic converter theft; and

WHEREAS, the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority Grant application will not exceed \$50,000 with 20% matching funds required; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City Manager assures that the grant funds will be returned in full to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has previously authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of a grant application to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority.

SECTION 2: The City Council reaffirms, directs, and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate this grant and to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Grant Program. Further, the Police Chief is the designated Program Director, and the Grant Administrator is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.

SECTION 3: Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the grant guidelines and all applicable state and federal guidance.

SECTION 5: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
