AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AMENDING THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 98, SECTION 98-107, NO PARKING ZONES, TO RESTRICT PARKING, STANDING, OR STOPPING ON RUDELOFF ROAD BETWEEN STATE HIGHWAY 46 AND THE EASTERNMOST INTERSECTION WITH HUBER ROAD; AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO PREPARE THIS ORDINANCE AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization awarded funding for the reconstruction of Rudeloff Road from State Highway 46 to Huber Road; and

WHEREAS, the existing no parking zone is not consistent with the signs currently posted on this portion of Rudeloff Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS

SECTION ONE. The Seguin Code of Ordinances, Chapter 98, Traffic and Vehicles, Article V, Stopping, Standing and Parking, Section 98-107 is amended to read as follows (underlining indicates added text, ~~strikethrough~~ indicates deleted text):

- (a) The following areas are designated no parking zones:
- (1) *Convent Street* from South Austin Street to South Milam Street.
 - (2) *Shelby Street* from Walnut Branch to South Milam Street.
 - (3) From the intersection of Huber and Rudeloff Road on the east side of Huber Road travelling 850 feet south.
 - ~~(4) Along the north side of Rudeloff Road between the two legs of Huber Road.~~
 - ~~(5) Both sides of the curve located at the northeast corner of the Fields of Huber Ranch.~~
- (b) The following areas are designated no parking, standing, or stopping zones:
- (1) Both sides of Rudeloff Road from SH 46 east to the easternmost intersection with Huber Road.
- (c) City staff is hereby directed to erect no parking signs in the appropriate blocks in accordance with this section.
- (d) Violations of this section shall be punished in accordance with the penalty provisions of the City of Seguin Code of Ordinances.

SECTION TWO. This Ordinance shall become effective beginning ten days after its publication.

SECTION THREE. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portions of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR. City Staff is hereby authorized to submit this Ordinance as a supplement to the Seguin Code of Ordinances.
