A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDING A BID TO SECOND SIGHT SYSTEMS FOR THE TWACS METER REPLACEMENT PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SECOND SIGHT SYSTEMS; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The Utilities Department is working to transition electric meters into a unified Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI); and

WHEREAS, approximately 5,300 Two-Way Automated Communication System (TWACS) meters need to be replaced due to outdated software; and

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned project is to replace approximately 5,300 TWACS electric meters across the utility's service area; and

WHEREAS, this project will improve billing accuracy, streamline utility operations, enhance remote data collection, prepare the network for integration with an Outage Management System (OMS); and

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids for the TWACS Meter Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, eleven bids were received ranging from a low bid of \$156,000.00 to a high bid of \$858,600.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin reserves the right to award this contract to the lowest responsible bidder or to the bidder who provides the "best value" for the City; and

WHEREAS, based on reference checks, City staff recommends accepting the lowest responsible bid of \$156,000.00 submitted by Second Sight Systems plus \$19,000.00 in contingency for a total amount of \$175,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The City Council of Seguin, Texas, hereby approves the bid award to Second Sight Systems in the amount of \$156,000.00 for the TWACS Meter Replacement Project, plus \$19,000.00 in contingency for a total amount of \$175,000.00.

Part 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Second Sight Systems for the TWACS Meter Replacement Project.

Part 3. This Resolution is effective from and after the date of its passing.
