A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$188,315 WITH COBB, FENDLEY & ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE HEIDEKE SIDEWALKS PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enhance pedestrian safety within the transportation network; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide a safe route to Weinert Elementary School; and

**WHEREAS**, Cobb, Fendley & Associates is on the City's indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity (IDIQ) list of qualified engineering firms to provide professional engineering services to the City in the roadway and transportation category; and

**WHEREAS**, the services to be performed by Cobb, Fendley & Associate, Inc. for the Project includes the full design of the sidewalks on the east side of Heideke Street from Braden Street to Kingsbury Street and along the east side of Bruns Street from Braden Street to E Pine Street; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff have negotiated a professional services agreement with Cobb, Fendley & Associates, Inc. for the purposes of a full design of sidewalks; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff recommends entering into a professional services agreement for this Project pursuant to the Agreement with Cobb, Fendley & Associates, Inc.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1**. The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby approves a Professional Services Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$188,315 with Cobb, Fendley & Associates, Inc. for engineering and other professional services for the Heideke Sidewalks Project.

**SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
