A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN TEXAS APPROVING A LOCAL HISTORICAL MARKER TO BE PLACED AT THE W.A. LEFTY STACKHOUSE MEMORIAL CLUB HOUSE LOCATED AT 650 RIVER DRIVE WEST

WHEREAS, the W.A. Lefty Stackhouse Memorial Club House located at 650 River Drive West inside Max Starcke Park was constructed in 1938 through FDR's New Deal; and

WHEREAS, Robert Hugman, designer of the San Antonio River Walk, was the designer/architect of Starcke Park, selecting Seguin native Marvin Eickenroht to design the club house; and

WHEREAS, the concrete clubhouse was designed in the art deco style with a balanced design, simple lines and minimal décor; and

WHEREAS, some minimal additions have been made, including a front porch and window replacement; and

WHEREAS, recognizing and preserving historical structures has been a long standing program for the City of Seguin; and

WHEREAS, the Seguin Conservation Society, the Historic Design Review Committee and the Guadalupe County Historical Commission have all approved of the placement of a local historical marker at the W.A. Stackhouse Memorial Club House and

WHEREAS, with the affirmative votes of the above groups the home meets the requirements for the placement of a local historical marker.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin:

SECTION ONE. The City Council hereby approves of the placement of a local historical marker at the W.A. Lefty Stackhouse Memorial Club House located at 650 River Drive West located in Max Starcke Park.
